JUNIOR REFEREES & PRIMARY SCHOOL OFFICIALS

(Approved VBRA May 2016 Board Meeting)

To cater for younger referees (10 – 12) who are involved in Primary School Competitions the VBRA introduces the following:

Grade as Level 1P & perhaps allow for a progression to Level 2P to recognise improvement.

Payment structure to be determined by the competition organisers.

To then progress, they must meet all requirements of a Level 1C referee (Theory & Practical – in line with VBRA Competencies Document).

Once Accredited they are Graded as a Level 1C referee, unless they are Under 14 years of age, where they are graded as a Junior Referee.

Once they reach age 14 they are then moved from Junior to Level 1C.

Remember this Grading from Junior to 1C only applies to fully accredited officials.

As for Licence Fees the following process will occur:

Those involved in Primary School Competitions only, are not required to pay a Licence Fee but their details should be listed on the referee contact details spreadsheet.

Junior Referees are not required to pay Licence Fees until they reach 14 years of age where they become Level 1C referees (as per the VBRA Rules of Management).

Junior Referees should also have their details listed on the referee contact details spreadsheet.
